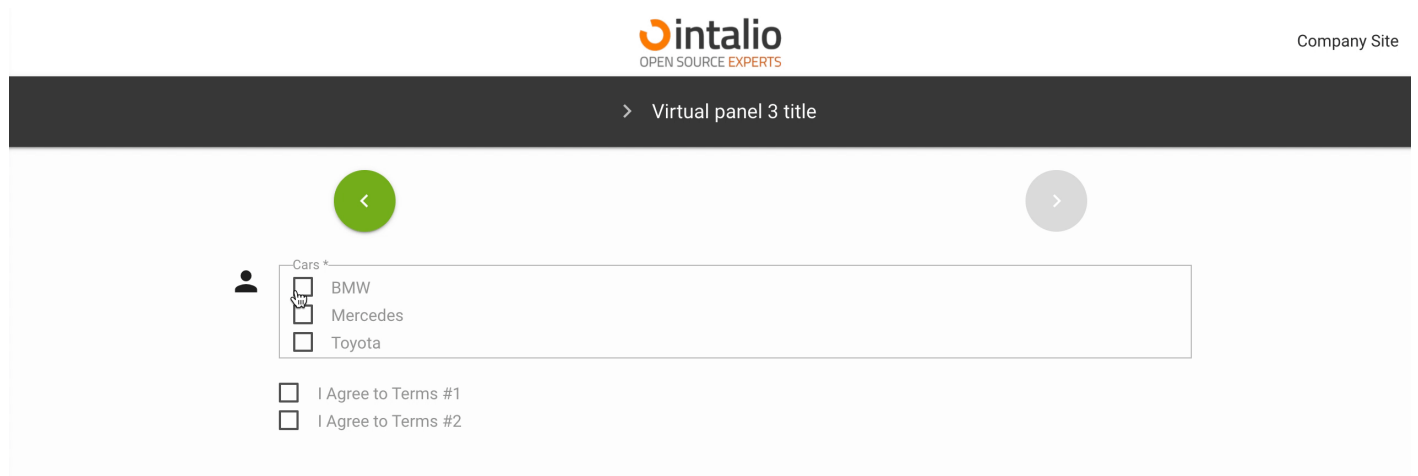


# Checkbox

## Checkbox (checkbox)

This field, which someone can select, appears in two versions - as a single field (e.g. for approval of a contract), or as a set of fields.
